Our work in Ukraine



The Russian attack on Ukraine has led to a dramatic humanitarian crisis where cities and densely populated areas are attacked with missiles and cluster bombs.

In Ukraine NPA is:

- Establishing a demining program.
- Cooperation and material support for demining through State Emergency Services Ukraine.
- Strengthening the Ukrainian democracy and the civil society's humanitarian response.

Reception and emergency accommodation

In Norway NPA is:

- Responsible for the refugee reception service at Oslo Airport Gardermoen. Here NPAs team is receiving and assisting refugees arriving in Norway.
- Running the emergency accommodation for Ukrainian refugees coming to Norway.
- Advocacy work for equal rights and living conditions.
- NPAs local volunteers all across Norway organize social activities together with Ukrainians; such as tour groups, language cafes, sports etc.
